





### **Finances**

## Main income (roughly \$23.500):

- ▶ \$ 5.000 Amazon sponsoring
- ▶ \$  $2.368 \approx 2000$ EUR AI Journal sponsoring
- ▶ \$  $1.184 \approx 1000$ EUR Springer sponsoring
- ▶ \$ 1.000 Imandra sponsoring
- ▶ \$14.000 registration fees (approximately)

### Main costs (roughly \$12.500):

- ▶  $$9.450 \approx 7850$ EUR Springer Gold Open Access
- ▶ \$2.000 two Herbrand awards
- ▶ \$  $374 \approx £270$  EasyChair License
- ▶ \$ 665 ConfTool costs (approximately)
